






### Projected Housing Occupancies: 2021-2025 & 2025-2030





### "Local Revenue in Excess of Entitlement" is recaptured by the state Recapture Estimates \$6.97M to \$10.22M

- The state fills in any space that is left.
- Local property taxes fill the glass first.


#### **GLASS = ENTITLEMENT**




### Total District Tax Rate Reductions Over Last 4 Years







### Recapture and M&O Tax Rates in DSISD 2013-2022










